Authors, affiliations and body text must be 12pt font. For body text, use single spacing and justified margins. The page setup is Letter (27,94cm x 21,59cm; 11in. x 8,5in.). Page margins are 2,54cm (1-in.) from the top, left, right and bottom. The abstract size is limited to <u>one page</u> (including title, authors, affiliations, body text, references, acknowledgements, etc.) and <u>400 words at most.</u> If your abstract include references, they must be made in brackets around the number, i.e. [1], at the end of the document.

Remember the abstract must be submitted in *.pdf format using the abstract submission utility at the conference website. Abstract submitted in the body of an email will not be accepted. Name the abstract file with the first name letter and last name of the conference participant author which is submitting the contribution. If more than one contribution is submitted, follow the last name with a proper numbering (e.g., Mr. John Smith may submit jsmith.pdf or jsmith1.pdf and jsmith2.pdf). Also, remember to delete this text before submission.
